Covid Safety Information

Covid-19 is still with us, so to minimise the chances of spreading the virus, please follow the protocols below which are in line with guidance from the RSCDS, Sport Scotland and Morningside Parish Church.

Dancing will be in the Braid Hall. Please enter and exit the building via the Braid Road door. Enter the hall using the first set of doors on your right. Please follow any one-way systems, guidelines, and restrictions the Church has in place.

Face **coverings** must be worn when entering or leaving the building or going to the toilet. Please use the toilets in the corridor beside the Braid Hall.

Face **coverings** are not required to be worn when dancing but are if you are sitting out.

We are required to keep attendance records for Track and Trace, so you will need to sign in every week when you arrive. If there is a case **of Covid 19 among our dancers**, NHS Track and Trace will contact those affected.

Please put your coat over the back of your seat.

Please bring your own hand sanitiser which we recommend you use between dances. The club will have sanitiser available in case you forget your own.

If you have been in contact with Covid-19 in the recent past or if you have any symptoms of it, please do not attend until you are in the clear.

Please notify us if you test positive within 10 days of attending the club.

If you start to feel unwell during the evening, please let a committee member know and return home immediately.

Consider taking a lateral flow test before coming to the club.

We will not have access to the kitchen and will not be providing refreshments, so please bring your own with you, as required.

We will have a designated Covid Officer at the club every night, should there be any queries or issues.

Please note that printed copies of crib sheets will not be available to avoid the possible spread of the virus. You should print your own – available on the website.
